I was thrilled to accept the Groundbreakers Award last week with my partner in Ossining leadership, Town Supervisor Dana Levenberg! From the MOGO initiative for cyclists and pedestrians, to the grants we have applied for seeking innovative transit solutions to connect our business, cultural and residential hubs--the Town and Village of Ossining are working together to strengthen our community for generations to come. It's official--last week the Village Board voted unanimously and enthusiastically for the 0% tax rate increase in the 2018 budget. We have found a responsible balance of conservative fiscal practices with progressive investment in our community. Smart policies, strong infrastructure, and the resources to guide and implement these priorities are essential for the economic development that makes a diverse, vibrant community. Westchester is one of the most expensive areas of the country to live in. Ossining remains more affordable than many of our neighbors, and we are doing our part to preserve the ability for residents of all income levels to make, and keep, this Village their home.
