This Week's Legislative Session

Wednesday's Session will begin with a Public Hearing on proposed Local Law 3-2018 regarding an update to our Affordable Housing policy. When the Village implemented our current Affordable Housing program in 2006, it was very progressive for its time. Ossining has now fallen behind most other Westchester communities. There is agreement among all members of the Board of Trustees that we need to update this law which determines the amount, and affordability, of units in new construction that will be set aside for the Village's Affordable Housing Program. On Wednesday, community members are invited to speak on the proposed legislative change. This proposed legislative action is different than another proposed program related to housing that has been a topic of much discussion, ETPA. ETPA is a NYS rent stabilization program. Both approaches to addressing housing challenges in Ossining are examined in the recommendations of the Housing Needs Assessment. <u>Click here to read the</u> recommended policy framework and strategy for implementation.

Because this week is a Legislative Session, it includes a number of invitations for community members to publicly comment. If you would like to spread the word about an upcoming event, please take up to two minutes during Organizational Announcements. Folks who would like to comment on the resolutions included on that night's agenda may do so for up to four minutes at the start of the Village Board Resolutions portion of the meeting. The meeting closes with an invitation for community members to comment for up to three minutes during Visitor Recognition about any topic of relevance to the common good of the Village.
