LOCAL LAW 4-2018 (Adopted)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the Regularly scheduled meeting of the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Ossining, which was held on Monday, September 17, 2018 the Village Board did adopt Local Law 8-2018 as Local Law 4-2018.

A Local Law amending Chapter 186 (Parades) of the Village of Ossining Code.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Ossining as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 186, section 2 (Application; contents; filing) is amended as follows with new matter <u>underlined</u> and deleted matter in [brackets]:

An application for the permit required in 186-1 shall be filed with the chief of police to the extent practicable not less than seven days before the event for which a permit is sought.[,]

The application shall be in writing, and shall contain the following information, to be furnished by the person in official charge thereof:

- A. The names of all organizations or persons organizing or sponsoring the parade, procession or gathering.
- B. The purpose of the parade, procession or gathering.
- C. The date and hour of the parade, procession or gathering.
- D. If a parade or procession, the proposed route thereof and its beginning and terminating points; and if an assembly or gathering, the location thereof.
- E. The number and type of vehicles, if any, marching units and floats.
- F. The approximate number of persons participating.

Section 2. Chapter 186, section 3 (Action on application) is amended as follows with new matter <u>underlined</u> and deleted matter in [brackets]:

The Chief of Police shall investigate all applications for permits required in 186-1, and, where the information specified in 186-2 has been furnished, provided that the proposed parade, procession or gathering [is otherwise lawful and] can be held without undue interference with vehicular and pedestrian traffic within the Village, shall make an affirmative recommendation to the Village Manager [Village Board of Trustees] who shall issue the permit.

Section 3. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State pursuant to section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
