#### Proposed Local Law 9-2022

A local law amending chapter 250 (Vehicles and Traffic) of the Village of Ossining Code.

#### BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Ossining as follows:

**Section 1.** Chapter 250 (Vehicles and Traffic) of the Village of Ossining Code is amended with new matter **underlined** and deleted matter in **[brackets]**.

#### § 250-1 Definitions.

- A. The words and phrases used in this chapter shall, for the purposes of this chapter, have the meanings respectively ascribed to them by Article 1 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.
- B. The following words and phrases, which are not defined by Article 1 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York, shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them in this section for the purposes of this chapter:

#### **COMMERCIAL VEHICLES**

#### (1) For the purposes of this chapter, "commercial vehicles" are defined as follows:

- (a) A trailer, boat, vessel, boat trailer or motor home, whether or not such vehicle is supported on wheels;
- (b) Any vehicle which, by reason of the attachment of advertising or commercial messages and/or storage of service equipment or other commercial merchandise or hardware, presents the outward appearance of a vehicle which is utilized primarily in the furtherance of commercial or industrial enterprise; or
- (c) Any vehicle which is defined or considered a "commercial vehicle" for the purposes of vehicle registration requirements of the State of New York.

#### CURBLINE

The prolongation of the lateral line of a curb or, in the absence of a curb, the lateral boundary line of the roadway.

#### HOLIDAYS

New Year's Day, [Lincoln's Birthday, Washington's Birthday], <u>Dr. Martin Luther</u> <u>King, Jr. Day, President's Day</u>, Memorial Day, <u>Juneteenth</u>, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

#### LOADING ZONE

An area of the street reserved for the loading and unloading of merchandise or other property, between designated hours and for a period of time never to exceed 15 minutes.

#### [Added 9-16-2003 by L.L. No. 6-2003]

#### **OFFICIAL TIME STANDARD**

Whenever certain hours are named herein or on traffic control devices, they shall mean

the time standard which is in current use in this state.

#### PARKING METER ZONE

A designated location upon or within which the parking of vehicles is regulated by parking meters.

#### PUBLIC PARKING LOT

A plot or parcel of land or building owned and/or leased by this Village, not including highways, upon or within which the parking of vehicles is regulated by signs and/or parking meters.

#### § 250-30 Parking at the railroad station.

- A. Railroad station [tag] parking areas.
- (1) The following on-street and off-street parking [facilities] **locations** constitute railroad station parking areas:
- (a) Lower Main Street lot (Section, Block and Lot numbers 97.07-1-29, 30 and 31) [Area No. 1, consisting of portions of Section 3, Plate 4, Block 5, Lots 1, IA, 2, 3A, and Section 3, Plate 4, Block 7, Lots 10 and 11,] as well as along adjacent Main Street, as posted by [tag]railroad station permit parking signs.
- (b) East Parking Field (East of railroad tracks) (Section, Block and Lot numbers 97.07-1-8, 9, 11, 12 and 16) [Area No. 2, consisting of portions of Section 3, Plate 15, Block 36, Lots 9 and 10,] as posted by [tag]railroad station permit parking signs.
- (c) <u>Barlow Lane lots (Section, Block and Lot numbers 97.07-18 and 19) as posted by</u> <u>railroad station permit parking signs.</u>
- (d) <u>Quimby Street East lot (Section, Block and Lot number 97.07-1-1 as posted by</u> railroad station permit parking signs.
- ([c]e) [Area No. 3, consisting of a portion of the] Westerly side of Westerly Road near the railroad station ramp, as posted by [tag] <u>railroad station permit</u> parking signs.

#### (f) <u>West Parking Field (west of railroad tracks) (Section, Block and Lot number 97.06-</u> <u>1-18), as posted by railroad station permit parking signs.</u>

- [(d) Area No. 4, consisting of Section 3, Plate 15, Block 34, Lot IB and portions of Block No. 25000 leased from Metro-North, as posted by [tag] <u>railroad station permit</u> parking signs.]
- ([e]g) [Area No. 5, along the] Easterly side of Westerly Road, as posted by [tag] <u>railroad</u> <u>station permit</u> parking signs.
- ([f]h) [Area No. 6, consisting of Section 3, Plate 4, Block 7, Lot 1, <u>Quimby Street West</u> as posted by [tag]<u>railroad station permit</u> parking signs.
- [(g) Area No. 7, consisting of Section 3, Plate 12, Block 26, Lots 13, 14 and 15, as posted by [tag] <u>railroad station permit</u> parking signs.]

- [(h) Area No. 8, along the southerly side of Central Avenue easterly from its intersection with Water Street, as posted by tag parking signs.]
- (i) [Area No. 9, along the] Easterly side of Water Street northerly between Central Avenue and Broadway, as posted by [tag]**railroad station permit** parking signs.
- (j) [Area No. 10, consisting of the] Old Broadway extension (former location of bridge) off Water Street, as posted by [tag]<u>railroad station permit</u> parking signs.
- (2) The municipal parking areas described in this **[sub]section** are hereby designated for both Village resident and nonresident use **except as herein noted**.
- B. Restricted hours of use. With the exception of parking in the Quimby Street East and Quimby Street West parking lots as detailed below, the use of unmetered parking areas or portions thereof in railroad station parking fields and lots [designated by Subsections A through J] is restricted to those who have valid station parking [tags] permits [from Monday through Fridays,] between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. [except as provided in Subsection G hereof.] [Amended 12-6-2004 by L.L. No. 12-2004]
- C. [Tags] **Permits** generally. No vehicle shall be parked in any such area during the time specified in Subsection **B** unless [such motor vehicle displays a tag to be issued by the Village] the Village Clerk has issued to the registered owner of the motor vehicle a railroad station permit. Vehicles will be identified by license plate numbers with the list of such vehicles and the corresponding license plate numbers maintained by the Village Clerk. [Such tag shall be placed on the front dashboard, driver's side of vehicle so as to fully display such tag by observation.] [Tags] Railroad station parking **permits** [permitting parking in the aforesaid restricted areas] may be obtained by any resident or nonresident of the Village by [executing] **submitting** an application [form] to the Village Clerk [whenever required by the Village] giving the name and address of the applicant, the registration number of the automobile for which the [tag] railroad station parking permit is sought, [and] such other information required to implement this section and the required fee as published in the village's annual fee schedule. The [tag] railroad station parking permit is not assignable by the permit holder. [shall be assignable to any person owning or leasing a motor vehicle bearing a registration number indicated on such tag by the Village at the time of issuance.]
- D. [Tag] <u>Railroad station parking permit</u> periods. [Tags] <u>Railroad station parking permits</u> shall be issued annually for the period January through December. <u>All railroad station parking permit shall expire on December 31 of the year the permit was issued.</u> [Amended 12-6-2004 by L.L. No. 12-2004]
- E. [Tag] <u>Railroad station parking permit</u> fees. The <u>annual fee[s]</u> charged for <u>railroad station</u> parking <u>permits</u> [tags] <u>must be paid before the permit is issued</u>. <u>Depending on permit availability and when the application is submitted, the fee may be prorated</u>. [for quarterly, semiannual, or annual periods shall be in such amounts as the Board of Trustees shall by resolution fix and determine.] <u>The Board of Trustees is responsible for determining the fee to be published in the annual fee schedule</u>.
- [F. Unauthorized use of tags. If an applicant for a tag shall permit the use of such tag on any unauthorized vehicle, or change any registration number affixed thereto, the parties

involved in such transaction shall not be permitted to obtain a tag for a period of two years.]

- [G]F. Overnight parking. Subject to regulations and restrictions set forth in this section, overnight parking will be allowed in the Lower Main Street lot [except with a railroad station parking tag all-night parking shall only be allowed in [Railroad Station Parking Area No. 7,] subject to availability, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.[, and tags sold for such space.] The [rate] fee for [tags] permits for overnight parking in the Main Street Lot for a semiannual or annual period shall be set by [in such amounts as] the Board of Trustees [shall by resolution fix and determine] and published in the annual fee schedule. [Amended 12-6-2004 by L.L. No. 12-2004]
- [H]<u>G</u>. Parking on Saturdays and Sundays. Parking <u>at the railroad station parking lots</u> shall be open to the general public on Saturdays and Sundays.
- [I]<u>H</u>. Parking on plaza level. Motor vehicles parked on the north side of the Metro North Station ramp on plaza level shall be backed to the curb.
- [J]<u>I</u>. Daily permits. [The Village is hereby authorized to sell daily parking permits for parking at the railroad station plaza, the cost of which shall be in such amounts as the Board of Trustees shall by resolution fix and determine.] <u>The Quimby Street East lot (97.07-1-1) will be designated as a "pay by day" railroad station parking lot between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The Board of Trustees shall determine the daily rate to be charged which rate will be published in the annual fee schedule. Between the hours of 7:00 a.m. the Quimby Street East parking lot will be available for overnight municipal parking, the fee to be published in the annual fee schedule.</u>
- **J.** Parking by the hour. The parking spaces at the Quimby Street West lot, west of Westerly Road are designated as parking by the hour. The hourly rate will be in effect Monday through Sunday, 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. The hourly fee to be charged for use of the parking spaces will be published in the annual fee schedule. The prohibition on overnight parking between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. shall not apply to vehicles parked at the Quimby Street location where the hourly rates have been paid and time has not expired.

## § 250-32 Parking time limits in designated municipal parking lots. [Amended 10-17-2000 by L.L. No. 3-2000; 8-7-2001 by L.L. No. 2-2001; 1-15-2002 by L.L. No. 2-2002; 2-17-2004 by L.L. No. 3-2004]

- A. Parking is prohibited for a period longer than two hours Monday through Saturday in designated portions of the following Municipal Parking Lots: Brandreth Street, North Highland Avenue East, Croton Avenue, Eastern Avenue and Waller Avenue south [Five, Six, Eight through Ten, Twelve and Thirteen] and parking is prohibited for a period longer than three hours Monday through Saturday in the Broadway North Municipal Parking Lot [Three], except as provided in § 250-33D and F. [Amended 3-3-2004 by L.L. No. 5-2004; 2-13-2006 by L.L. No. 2-2006; 3-7-2006 by L.L. No. 3-2006; 2-20-2007 by L.L. No. 3-2007]
- B. Parking is prohibited in <u>the Broadway North</u> [Municipal] <u>Parking</u> Lot [Three at all times] between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. and in <u>the Spring/Main West</u> [Municipal] <u>Parking</u> Lot [Five (west side of Spring Street and Main Street) at all times] between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. [Amended 2-20-2007 by L.L. No. 3-2007]
- C. Parking is prohibited in the Spring/Main East [Municipal] Parking Lot [Six (east side

of Spring and Main Streets) at all times] between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 2:00 p.m. on Saturdays **throughout the year** [from June 1 to December 31 in each year]. Any vehicle parked in violation of this subsection shall be deemed to constitute an obstruction to traffic and will be subject to removal by the Village [pursuant to the provisions of § 250-34B].

- D. Visitor parking at the Municipal Building <u>Lot</u> is hereby permitted Monday through Friday in <u>designated</u> metered spaces <u>allowing for one hour parking</u>. [where designated in Municipal <u>Parking</u> Lot One, while conducting business at the Municipal Building]. Metered parking for the use of visitors to the Municipal Building shall be established in the first five parking spaces along the easterly side of the driveway entrance to Municipal <u>Parking</u> Lot One, which shall be designated "one-hour metered parking." The remaining [38] <u>parking</u> spaces are designated for municipal employee parking <u>only</u>. [Amended 3-15-2011 by L.L. No. 2-2011]
- E. <u>Parking is prohibited along Central Avenue, south side (Municipal Linear Parking Lot 16) between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Monday through Sunday except for holders of overnight municipal parking permits who have submitted an application and paid the fee as published in the annual fee schedule. Between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Sunday parking in the Central Avenue Municipal Linear Parking Lot will be permit parking for employees of businesses on Main Street. The fee for such permit parking will be set by the Board of Trustees and published in the annual fee schedule.</u>
- [E]F. [Municipal] The State Street Parking Lot [Two] has 40 parking spaces [designated] only to be used by [for] members of the Ossining Volunteer Fire Department [of the Village of Ossining] and municipal employees [parking]. The village shall develop a process for identifying those vehicles which may legally park in the State Street Parking Lot.[ [Amended 2-13-2006 by L.L. No. 2-2006; 1-8-2008 by L.L. No. 1-2008]
- [F]G. [Municipal] <u>The Broadway North Parking</u> Lot [Three] has 67 <u>parking</u> spaces designated as three-hour parking. [Amended 2-20-2007 by L.L. No. 3-2007]
- [G]H. [Municipal] The Spring/Main Street West Parking Lot [Five] has 43 spaces designated as [three-hour parking] timed parking available from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Monday through Sunday, overnight parking from 8:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. and parking for no charge between 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. [and]The Spring/Main Street Municipal Lot Five also has 25 parking spaces designated as long-term parking requiring a municipal permit as detailed in section 250-33, which long-term parking spaces shall also be designated as three-hour parking on Saturdays between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. [Amended 11-7-2007 by L.L. No. 13-2007; 1-8-2008 by L.L. No. 1-2008]
- [H]I. [Municipal] <u>The Spring/Main Street East Parking</u> Lot [Six] has 19 spaces designated as [three-hour parking] <u>timed parking available from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00</u> <u>p.m. Monday through Sunday, overnight parking from 8:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. and</u> <u>parking for no charge between 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.</u> [and]<u>Municipal Parking</u> <u>Lot six also has</u> [six] <u>6</u> spaces <u>designated</u> as long-term parking <u>requiring a municipal</u> <u>permit as detailed in section 250-33</u>.

- I. [Municipal] <u>The Broadway South Parking</u> Lot [Seven] has 18 spaces designated as two-hour parking, 19 spaces as long-term parking and 9 spaces as municipal vehicles only. [Amended 2-20-2007 by L.L. No. 3-2007; 1-8-2008 by L.L. No. 1-2008]

[Municipal] <u>The North Highland Avenue East Parking</u> Lot [Nine] has [two] <u>2</u> <u>parking</u> spaces designated as half-hour metered parking, [four] <u>4 parking</u> spaces designated as two-hour metered parking and [three] <u>3 parking</u> spaces as long-term parking <u>requiring a municipal permit as detailed in section 250-33</u>. - M. [Municipal] <u>The Eastern Avenue Parking</u> Lot [Twelve] has [two] <u>2 parking</u> spaces designated as two-hour parking and [eight] <u>8 parking</u> spaces as long-term parking <u>requiring a municipal permit as detailed in section 250-33</u>.
- N. [Municipal] <u>The Waller Avenue South Parking</u> Lot [Thirteen] has 13 <u>parking</u> spaces designated as two-hour parking and [eight] <u>parking</u> spaces as long-term parking <u>requiring a municipal permit as detailed in section 250-33</u>.

A. [Tag]<u>Permit</u> parking is permitted in designated <u>parking</u> spaces of <u>the following</u> Municipal <u>Parking</u> Lots: <u>Broadway north, Spring/Main Street west, Spring/Main</u> <u>Street East, Broadway south, Brandreth Street, North Highland Avenue east,</u> <u>Croton Avenue, Eastern Avenue, Waller Avenue south, Waller Avenue north, St.</u> <u>Paul's Place and Central Avenue Municipal Linear Parking</u>. [One through Three and Five through Ten and Twelve through Fifteen; provided,] However, [that] no [parking tags]<u>permits</u> shall be issued to commercial vehicles[, as hereinafter defined, in] **for** any municipal **parking lot[s]**. [Parking tags]**Permits for parking in municipal parking lots** will be issued by the Village Clerk's office for annual periods from January 1 through December 31 upon **submission of a complete application including** the payment of such fees [therefor as] **set by** the Board of Trustees [shall by resolution fix and determine]. **Fees will be published in the annual fee schedule.** [Parking tags]**Permits** purchased after January 1 will be sold by the Village Clerk's office on a pro-rated basis as determined by the fees set by the Board of Trustees.

- [(1) For the purposes of this section, "commercial vehicles" are defined as follows:
- (a) A trailer, boat, vessel, boat trailer or motor home, whether or not such vehicle is supported on wheels;
- (b) Any vehicle which, by reason of the attachment of advertising or commercial messages and/or storage of service equipment or other commercial merchandise or hardware, presents the outward appearance of a vehicle which is utilized primarily in the furtherance of commercial or industrial enterprise; or
- (c) Any vehicle which is defined or considered a "commercial vehicle" for the purposes of vehicle registration requirements of the State of New York.]
- B. Except as otherwise stated [herein] <u>in this chapter</u>, the [parking tags]<u>permits</u> described in Subsection A of this section, [when visibly displayed,] shall provide for [either] daytime parking between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., nighttime parking between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m., or twenty-four-hour parking in the aforesaid <u>parking</u> lots[:]. <u>Vehicle license plate numbers shall be used to determine if</u> <u>a vehicle is legally parked in any municipal parking lot.</u>
- [(1) Tags designated for daytime parking shall display the word "Day," the tag expiration date and the license plate number of the vehicle associated with the tag.
- (2) Tags designated for nighttime parking shall display the word "Night," the tag expiration date and the license plate number of the vehicle associated with the tag. "Night" parking in Municipal Lots One, Five and Six shall be from 8:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. only.
- (3) Tags which display the words "24 hour," the tag expiration date and the license plate number associated with the tag may be used for both day and night parking.]
- [C. Tags which display the words/terms "Day," "Night" or "24 hour" are valid in all municipal public lots listed in § 250-31, except Municipal Lot One. Tags which display an "F" are valid in Municipal Lot Two only.
- (1) Tags which display a "Day" tag may be used for daytime parking not to exceed periods defined in Subsection **B** of this section, except for Lot 1.
- (2) Tags which display a "Night" tag may be used for nighttime parking not to exceed periods defined in Subsection **B** of this section.]
- (3) Tags which display an "E" are valid for all periods defined in Subsection **B** of this section and shall be issued only to Village employees.
- (4) Tags which display an "F" are valid for all periods defined in Subsection B of this

section and shall be issued only to members of the Village of Ossining Fire Department.]

- [DC]. Permits issued for nighttime parking, with the exception of Central Avenue south [Tags which display a "Night" tag shall be valid for nighttime parking in Municipal Lots One through Three, Five through Ten, and Twelve through Fifteen and] shall also be valid in spaces otherwise designated for two-hour parking in such lots between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 8:00 a.m., without restriction as to time limitation during such hours.
- [E. Tags which display an "E" shall be valid for daytime and evening parking in all municipal lots listed in § **250-31**, except Municipal Lots Five and Six.]

Parking shall be permitted in [Municipal Lots Three, Seven and Eight] <u>Broadway</u> <u>north, Broadway south and Brandreth Street parking lots</u> (except in those areas designated for handicapped parking and municipal vehicles) for temporary purposes in connection with Recreation Department programs for such times as are provided in a temporary recreation parking permit to be issued by the Recreation Department.

### Article V Miscellaneous Provisions

#### § 250-37 Fines and penalties for offenses. [Amended 9-17-2013 by L.L. No. 3-2013]

- A. Every person convicted of a traffic infraction, as set forth in a parking summons, violation notice, appearance ticket and/or other accusatory instrument, for a violation of any provision of this chapter which is not a traffic violation under any provision of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York shall, for a first conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$100 or by imprisonment for not more than 15 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment; for a second such conviction within 18 months thereafter, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than 45 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment; upon a third or subsequent conviction within 18 months after the first conviction, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300 or by imprisonment of not more than 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- B. A failure to respond to a traffic infraction by the date and time of the assigned court date reflected on the face thereof will be deemed an admission of liability and a default judgment may be entered accordingly, and, given that such failure to respond will result in additional costs to the Village and the Court and the expenditure of other resources, the Village and/or the Court, in its discretion, may establish and/or impose penalties in addition to the fines established for violations of traffic infractions in this chapter and elsewhere. Such penalties may be assessed by the Court having jurisdiction over such traffic infractions as authorized in the normal course of judicial business and shall be established by resolution of the Village Board and included in a fee schedule to be maintained by the Village Clerk. Where a parking summons, violation notice, appearance ticket or other accusatory instrument (collectively "ticket") for a violation of any provision of this chapter which is not a traffic violation under any provision of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York is not responded to by the defendant by the appearance date on the notice, the fine to be imposed

shall be increased as follows:

- Where there is no response to the ticket for forty-five (45) days from the ticket issuance date the fine shall be doubled.
- Where there is no response to the ticket for sixty (60) days from the ticket issuance date, the fine shall be tripled.
- <u>Where there is no response to the ticket for ninety (90) days from the ticket</u> <u>issuance date, the fine shall be quadrupled.</u>

#### Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>

This local law shall take effect twenty-one (21) days after filing with the Secretary of <u>State.</u>
