Thanks go out to Senator David Carlucci for holding a Town Hall Meeting at Ossining's Community Center last Thursday. It was a great opportunity to learn more about the new legislation passed this year by both the Senate and Assembly. I enjoyed participating in the Q&A and was, as usual, impressed by the depth of knowledge demonstrated by engaged members of our community. Questions notably remain about school funding, marijuana, healthcare, AIM funding for local governments, and drivers licenses regardless of documentation status. Constituents who have concerns about these or any other matters related to state government still have time to reach out to Albany representatives!

Wednesday's work session included an exciting update to the Clean Streets initiative launching next month in the Village. Thank you to the dedicated members of the Downtown Development Fund Council for leading this
