At 7PM tomorrow, join us at the Ossining Public Library to learn more about efforts to update the Village of Ossining Comprehensive Plan. To encourage the whole community to attend, Spanish language translation will be provided.

The Comprehensive Plan is the foundation that shapes development, community revitalization, and preservation efforts in the Village for generations to come. Public

Last week's work session agenda included discussions related to two parks. We began with a visit from Ossining School Superintendent Ray Sanchez and Village Recreation & Parks Superintendent Bill Garrison to discuss implementation of a proposed Learning Trail at Nelson Sitting Park funded by a grant from the United Way. Immediately following that item, the Village Board heard a presentation to name the Gregory C Jackson Jr Memorial Skate Park at Snowden Park. The Village Board will be voting on a resolution this week in support of the naming of the skate park. Community members will then embark on fundraising efforts to cover the costs of the signage. 
took place at last week's work session.
