SPRING STREET TWO WAY LOCAL LAW 2, 2015

BIRDSALL-FAGAN POLICE COURT FACILITY 86-88 SPRING STREET, OSSINING, NY Please be aware a **Public Hearing is scheduled for tonight Wednesday, May 20th at 7:30 p.m.** during the Village of Ossining Board Meeting, 86-88 Spring Street, Ossining. This is in regard to the traffic pattern changes on Spring Street. Narrative Summary:

The law removes the one-way portion of Spring Street from the Schedule of One-Way Streets and permits two-way traffic.

The law makes permanent the removal of some parking spaces along a portion of Spring Street (both sides) in the vicinity of the Main Street intersection to accommodate turning east and west onto Main Street from Spring Street.

The law proposes a loading zone on Maple Street to avoid box truck loading and unloading along Spring Street.

The law proposes a reduced speed from 30 mph (the standard throughout the Village) to 25 mph on that portion of Spring Street from Broad to Main.

Proposed Local Law:

INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW NO. 2-2015

CODE REVISIONS TO MAKE PERMANENT CHANGE IN TRAFFIC PATTERN, SPEED AND PARKING ON SPRING STREET

A LOCAL LAW amending Chapter 250 of the Village Code of the Village of Ossining entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" to codify a change in the traffic pattern from a one way street to a two way street on a portion of Spring Street, with ancillary prohibition on some street parking and the designation of a loading zone on the adjacent Maple Place, and the lowering of the speed limit from 30 mph to 25 mph on Spring Street from Broad Avenue to Main Street.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Ossining, as follows:

Section 1. Section 250-39 Schedule H "Speed Limits" is hereby amended as follows, with new matter underlined:

Spring Street 25 From Broad Avenue to Main Street

Section 2. Section 250-41. Schedule IV "One-Way Streets" is hereby amended as follows, with deleted matter in [brackets]:

[Spring Street] [North] [From St. Paul's Place to Main Street]

Section 3. Section 250-49. Schedule XII "Parking Prohibited at All Times" is hereby amended as follows, with new matter underlined and deleted matter in [brackets]:

Spring Street East From Main Street to a point [100] 161 feet

south thereof

Spring Street West From Main Street to a point [100] <u>284</u> feet south[west] thereof.

Section 4. Section 250-55. Schedule XVIII "Time Limit Parking" is hereby amended as follows, with new matter <u>underlined</u> and deleted matter in [brackets]:

Spring Street West 1 hour: 9:00 a.m. From a point [100] 284 feet south

> To 6:00 p.m./All days of Main Street to a point 50 feet

except Sundays north of St. Paul's Place

and holidays

Spring Street East 1 hour; 9:00 a.m. From a point 20 feet north

> To 6:00 p.m./All days of Maple Place to a point [100] 161

except Sundays feet south of Main Street

and holidays

B.

Effective with the enactment of §250-33.1 of the Code, parts of certain streets set forth hereinabove previously designated as time limit parking shall be designated as parking meter zones pursuant to §250-62.1, Schedule XXVI: Parking Meter Zones, and shall be governed by the provisions of such §250-331. The time limits on parking in such Parking Meter Zones shall be visually displayed on signs and/or the meters themselves.

Section 250-57. Schedule XX: "Loading Zones" is hereby amended as Section 5.

follows, with new matter underlined:

Name of Street Side Location

Maple Street From a point which is 20 feet east of Spring South

Street to a point 30 feet east thereof

Except as otherwise provided herein, all other provisions of Chapter 250 Section 6. "Vehicles and Traffic" shall remain the same.

Section 7. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon publication, filing and posting as required by law.
