

About the DRI Boundary



- The DRI Boundary indicates where a community wants to focus its revitalization efforts.
- An initial DRI Boundary was included in the Village of Ossining's DRI Application. It includes the Village's **downtown Main Street corridor** and its **public waterfront**. The area is populated by residents who represent the Village's **ethnic and economic diversity**.
- As part of the DRI planning process, it may be determined that, the initial boundary should be modified to address local issues or capitalize on opportunities.
- The area encompasses several Village-owned properties, which present unique opportunities for public-private partnerships that would spur economic development and create benefits beyond the DRI Boundary.
