Sing Sing Prison Museum Project Prepares for a New Phase; Hidden Cove Permit Not Yet Granted

Over the weekend the dedicated members of the Sing Sing Prison Museum Board gathered for a day-long retreat to chart our path for the next 18 months, which is when the Preview Center is scheduled to open. So much needs to happen in that time. Thankfully this group is comprised of a tremendous wealth of experience and vision.

The item on last week's agenda that demanded the lion's share of our attention was the public hearing on Hidden Cove, the proposed development on the

property where the Brandreth Pill Factory once stood. The Board voted to close the public hearing, but has not yet voted on a resolution to grant a Waterfront Special Permit.
