

LOCAL LAW NO. 2-2011

VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC
METERED PARKING IN DESIGNATED SPACES
MUNICIPAL LOT ONE

A LOCAL LAW amending Chapter 250 of the Village Code of the Village of Ossining entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", Article III, Section 250-32 "Parking Time Limits in Designated Municipal Parking Lots" Subsection D, and Article VI "Schedules", Section 250-62.2 Schedule XXVII entitled "Off-Street Metered Parking Lots" to establish five metered parking spaces in Municipal Lot One for use by visitors to the Municipal Building

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Ossining, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 250 of the Village Code "Vehicles and Traffic", Article III "Parking, Standing and Stopping" Section 250-32, "Parking Time Limits in Designated Municipal Parking Lots", Subsection D is hereby amended as follows, with new matter underlined and deleted matter in [brackets]:

Visitor parking at the Municipal Building is hereby permitted Monday through Friday in metered spaces where designated in Municipal Lot One, while conducting business at the Municipal Building. [Visitor] Metered parking for the use of visitors to the Municipal Building shall be established in the first five parking spaces along the easterly side of the driveway entrance to [the] Municipal [Parking] Lot One, which shall be designated "one-hour metered parking." The remaining 38 spaces are designated for municipal employee parking.

Section 2. Chapter 250 of the Village Code "Vehicles and Traffic", Article VI "Schedules" Section 250-62.2 Schedule XXVII: "Off-Street Metered Parking Lots" is hereby amended as follows, with new matter underlined:

In accordance with the provisions of Section 250-33.1, off-street metered parking lots are established as follows:

Name of Lot

Municipal Lot One 1 hour (5 spaces)

Municipal Lot Nine ½ hour (2 spaces) and 2 hours (4 spaces)

Section 3. Except as otherwise provided herein, all other provisions of Chapter 250 "Vehicles and Traffic" shall remain the same.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon publication and posting as required by law.
