## LOCAL LAW NO. 3-2013 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC LAW REVISION

A LOCAL LAW amending Chapter 250 of the Village Code of the Village of Ossining entitled Wehicles and Traffic+:

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Ossining, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 250 of the Village Code Wehicles and Traffic+, Article V Renalties for offenses+is hereby amended as follows, with new matter underlined:

§250-37. Fines and Penalties for offenses.

- A. Every person convicted of a traffic infraction, as set forth in a parking summons, violation notice, appearance ticket and/or other accusatory instrument, for a violation of any provision of this Chapter which is not a traffic violation under [of] any provision of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York shall, for a first conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$100 or by imprisonment for not more than 15 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment; for a second such conviction within 18 months thereafter, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$200 or by imprisonment for not more than 45 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment; upon a third or subsequent conviction within 18 months after the first conviction, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300 or by imprisonment of not more than 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- B. A failure to respond to a traffic infraction by the date and time of the assigned court date reflected on the face thereof will be deemed an admission of liability and a default judgment may be entered accordingly, and given that such failure to respond will result in additional costs to the Village and the Court and the expenditure of other resources, the Village and/or the Court, in its discretion may establish and/or impose penalties in addition to the fines established for violations of traffic infractions in this Chapter and elsewhere. Such penalties may be assessed by the Court having jurisdiction over such traffic infractions as authorized in the normal course of judicial business and shall be established by resolution of the Village Board and included in a fee schedule to be maintained by the Village Clerk.
- Section 2. Subsection %N+ of Section 250-31 %Rublic Lots+ is deleted in its entirety.
- Section 3. Subsection %Q+of Section 250-32 %Rarking time limits in designated municipal parking lots+is deleted in its entirety.
- Section 4. Except as otherwise provided herein, all other provisions of Chapter 250 Wehicles and Traffic+shall remain the same.
- Section 5. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon publication, filing and posting as required by law.
