

LOCAL LAW NO. 5-2016

VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC LAW REVISION FOR OSAGE DRIVE NEIGHBORHOOD AND
DELEGATION TO VILLAGE MANAGER OF POWERS PREVIOUSLY RESERVED TO
BOARD OF TRUSTEES

A LOCAL LAW amending Chapter 250 of the Village Code of the Village of Ossining entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" to address traffic and circulation concerns of residents in the neighborhood of Osage Drive with further additions to Chapter 250 to provide for the authority and establish appropriate criteria and due process for delegation to the Village Manager of certain powers currently reserved for the Board of Trustees under this Chapter.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Ossining, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 250 of the Village Code "Vehicles and Traffic", Article VI "Schedules" Section 250-46. "Schedule IX: Stop Intersections." is hereby amended as follows, with new matter underlined:

Section 2. Chapter 250 of the Village Code "Vehicles and Traffic", Article VI "Schedules" Section 250-47. "Schedule X: Yield Intersections." is hereby amended as follows, with new matter underlined:

Section 3. Chapter 250-3 of the Village Code "Schedules; Adoption of Regulations" is hereby amended with the addition of the following

- C. Pursuant to the authority of §1603 of the NYS Vehicle and Traffic Law, the powers of the Board of Trustees to: designate places within the Village where parking, stopping or standing is prohibited, limited or restricted; designate parking meter zones; designate places within the Village where handicapped parking is permitted; designate through highways; and designate an intersection as a stop intersection or as a yield intersection

and to order and install signs implementing such designations are hereby delegated to the Village Manager.

- (1) All actions by the Village Manager pursuant to this delegation of authority shall be taken only after:
 - (a) Consideration of the volume and nature of traffic, the needs of the public for parking facilities and public safety and convenience.
 - (b) Obtaining the views of the Police Department and consulting with such state, county and Village departments and agencies and others as deemed appropriate by the Village Manager.
 - (c) Publication as traffic rules and regulations of the Village of Ossining in in the official newspaper of the Village.
 - (d) Filing with the Village Clerk on or before publication.
- (2) All rules and regulations or amendments thereto so published and filed shall become effective not less than 30 days after publication on a date stated therein, unless theretofore vetoed or suspended by resolution of the Board of Trustees; provided, however, that if the Village Manager determines that an emergency exists, such rules and regulations, or any amendment thereof shall become effective and the date specified by therein by the Village Manager.
- (3) Any order, rule or regulation, or amendment thereof issued by the Village Manager pursuant to this section shall be subject to revocation or suspension by resolution of the Board of Trustees on appeal by any aggrieved party to the Board of Trustees at any meeting thereof held prior to the effective date of any such order, rule or regulation, or on its own motion at any time.
- (4) All signs and markings required by the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York in connection with parking controls contained in rules and regulations, issued by the Village Manager pursuant to delegations of authority made in this section, shall be posted by the Village Manager on or before the effective date of the rules and regulations requiring such signs and markings. Such signs and markings shall be maintained by the Village Manager for so long as the rules and regulations requiring them remain in effect.

Section 4. Except as otherwise provided herein, all other provisions of Chapter 250 "Vehicles and Traffic" shall remain the same.

Section 5. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon publication, filing and posting as required by law.
