

RESOLUTION GRANTING HONORARY STREET NAME FOR JOSEPH BURTON JR.

WHEREAS, Joseph Burton Jr. began his career with the Village of Ossining Police Department on August 16, 1967 and, after having spent twenty-four years as a dedicated patrolman, he was appointed as the Chief of Police where he has served with distinction for twenty-four additional years and now stands as the longest serving chief in the history of the Village of Ossining; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees wishes to honor Chief Burton on the occasion of his retirement from the Village of Ossining as its Chief of Police with the designation of an honorary street name to commemorate his achievements and as a show of the respect he so richly deserves.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that effective December 31, 2015, that section of street officially dedicated in the Village of Ossining records as Spring Street between Academy Place and Main Street shall be designated with the honorary name of "Chief Burton Way".
